All children are encouraged to take personal pride in their appearance and to gain a sense of identity and belonging by wearing the St Patrick's uniform.

The school colour is bottle green and school jumpers, and cardigans and tshirts are available to order online. See the link below.

The uniform is as follows -

Boys – grey or black trousers (grey or black school shorts in the summer), white shirt or polo shirt and green jumper or sweatshirt with the school emblem (optional), black or grey socks,

Girls – grey or black skirt/ pinafore dress / trousers (green and white gingham dress in the summer), white polo shirt and green sweatshirt or cardigan with the school emblem (optional), black or grey socks or black or grey tights (white socks in summer). Skirts should be knee length.

Children are required to wear black sensible shoes, with a sturdy sole. Trainers will only be allowed for PE.

All children are required to have a PE kit of white crew neck t-shirt and grey or black PE shorts. All children will need clothing suitable for outdoor games in winter (fleece or sweatshirt and joggers). Very short, tight fitting shorts are not permitted.

All uniform should be clearly marked with your children's names.

Jewellery and Valuable Items

For Health and Safety reasons we ask that jewellery worn in school is confined to stud earrings and small wristwatches. The accidental pulling and catching of earrings, rings and necklaces during play can cause severe damage.

Children are asked to remove studs during PE / games and swimming. The school cannot accept any responsibility for the loss or damage of jewellery and watches.

We also ask parents to ensure that items of value are not brought into school. This includes expensive watches, jewellery mobile phones etc.

Haircuts

Extreme haircuts are not allowed in school at any time, for example patterns shaved into the head or partial or fully shaved heads. Children should not come to school with hair colour of any type.

Hair accessories are to be plain green or white, no large bows are permitted. Temporary or permanent tattoos are not permitted.

Painted or false nails are not permitted.
